The Challenge

Finding a 'real time' agile solution that can support a

high risk and multifaceted business both on/offshore.

No task is so important that we can't take the time to do it safely. A safe company is a successful company, so minimising and mitigating risks is a priority for ConocoPhillips.

Identifying a software solution that could support our teams in the field while giving real time overview to our Safety Leaders was imperative.

The Goals

- A single cloud-based software system to manage onboarding,

licenses, and insurances for 3PL contractors.

- An easy-to-access and easy-to-use portal/interface for end users, including full mobile functionality.
- High Risk Work Management, Work Permitting, and Safety Management.
- Comprehensive, real-time reporting.
- Clear, 'traffic light' system to provide visual indication of compliance to legislation and Caltex's compliance framework.

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Finding the Right Fit

ConocoPhillips required a system that could be implemented 'Out-of-the-Box' (OOTB), and then be configured to the specific requirements of a high risk, large multifaceted business and scaled when required. They needed a solution that could be implemented quickly and easily, whilst also being highly configurable which is an important aspect of our continuous improvement program. It's always a challenge implementing new systems, particularly where there is a reliance on multiple stakeholders, so finding an agile and responsive provider was a key driver for ConocoPhillips. Beakon have delivered exceptional customer service standards, and Beakon remain flexible to meet evolving needs. Always available to map out config changes and advise on how best to achieve goals. These were key factors in appointing Beakon.

The Outcomes

Conscious that Beakon delivers OOTB best practice as an ISO compliant framework, ConocoPhillips elected to initially use Beakon with minimal customisations, deploying the system to a live environment and making changes as required. This has been instrumental in centralising our contractor and thirdparty compliance management whilst also delivering operational efficiencies".

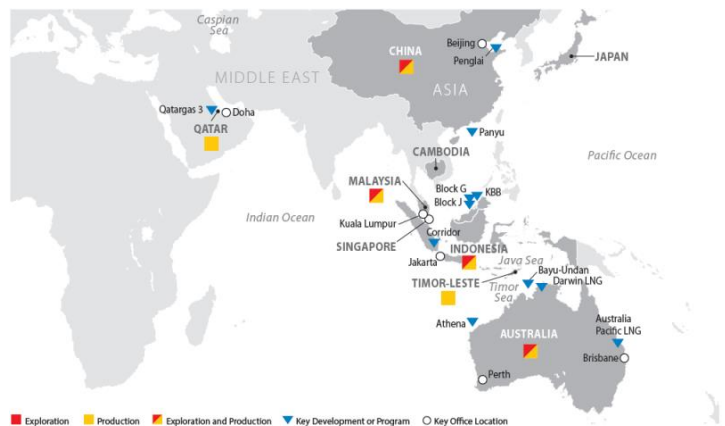
Advice for Others

We had a very tight timeframe to implement the Beakon system. Whilst the implementation timeline was a challenge, it was

important to get the fundamentals right, and adopt a staged approach which meant using most functionality 'Out of the Box'. Fortunately, Beakon's off-the shelf framework is ISO-based and very robust and in the end, we found this more than met our base-level requirements.

Now that we have delivered Phase 1 of our Contractor and Third-Party compliance systems, we are now in a position to further enhance the Beakon system's functionality and utilisation to deliver an operationally efficient tool for our staff and contractors/ third-parties.
